Limitations:

- Installation must comply with ITI Decking Guide instructions.
- Installation to be carried out by trade qualified or LBP registered personnel.
- Suitable for various New Zealand environments, in accordance with local building codes and regulations.
- Any fixings or metals in contact must be stainless steel type 316.

Design Requirements:

- Specifically designed for spotted gum wood usage in residential and commercial decking in New Zealand.
- Compatible with framing types as per NZS 3604 (2011).

Installation:

- In accordance with ITI NZ Decking Guide Version 4.
- Detailed guidelines provided for timber cutting, coating, and fixing specifics for spotted gum wood.

Maintenance:

- Regular maintenance as detailed in ITI NZ Decking Guide for spotted gum.
- Includes cleaning, inspection, and re-application of finishes as per coating manufacturer's requirements.
- Maintenance frequency:
 - ✓ Coastal, industrial, inner-city areas: At least every 12 months, or more frequently if needed.
 - ✓ Sheltered, inland areas: Every 12 to 18 months.
